A leader among environmentally sustainable steel manufacturers. Rider Steel recycles scrap metal into construction steel at two plants: Tema (80,000 tonnes a year, opened 2012) and Kumasi at Konongo-Odumase (300,000 tonnes a year, built with IFC support).

QUALITY

Made to GS 788-2:2018 under GSA licence GSA-PCM-L-A-2224-001 and approved under the ECOWAS Trade Liberalisation Scheme. Every bar is tested in our own laboratory and carries a rolled-in mark and batch number.

SUSTAINABILITY

Around 150,000 tonnes of scrap are recycled every year. A 4.3 MW rooftop solar system powers part of the Kumasi plant, and our dust-collection system captures 95% of emissions.
